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#### HIE Brings Higher Quality, Lower Costs

Health information exchange (HIE) continues to improve care quality, enhance patient safety, and reduce healthcare costs, but more providers need to employ HIE to maximize its potential, according to a report to the community from HEALTHELINK.


HEALTHELINK has worked to increase HIE in Western New York over the past year, reaching and then surpassing a million patient consents in 2017. In addition, approximately 96 percent of consented patients authorize their health information to be shared among treating providers.

As a part of the SHIN-NY, HEALTHELINK allows participating physicians to access patient data from outside Western New York. Physicians can also see if there is clinical information on their patients from other New York regional health exchange organizations.

# Use of ADT Notifications Jumped 95% Last Year Among SHIN-NY Users

A recent *EHR Intelligence* article discussed the preliminary report NYeC released last month on the usage of **Statewide Health Information Network for New York (SHIN-NY)** services. Researchers in the study analyzed the rate at which users of the SHIN-NY utilized Admittance, Discharge, Transfer Alerts notifications and query-based exchange services from three Qualified Entitles (QEs) over a one-year period.

Ultimately, researchers found ADT notification utilization increased by 95 percent between 2016 and 2017, while query-based health data exchange associated with alerts jumped by 102 percent.

The next phase of the multi-part study will analyze potential cost savings and patient outcomes with the usage of alerts and corresponding queries.

#### MIPS Reporting is Complete. Now What?

MIPS Eligible Clinicians had to submit their data to CMS by March 31st. Looking ahead to Year 2 MIPS reporting, requirements increase. Quality measures performance will be reported for the full year and cost efficiency will be weighted into final scores. Clinicians are strongly encouraged to take the lessons learned from MIPS 2017 reporting and define their 2018 quality initiatives now. During the reporting process, practices often learn that their documentation may not be comprehensive enough or their EHRs are not capturing the data to easily report their quality activity as defined by CMS specifications. Now is the time to refine your processes and prepare for 2018.

#### Why Your MIPS Score Matters

Did you know your MIPS score can follow you? For MIPS Eligible Clinicians that earn a MIPS score in 2018 and move to a new practice or organization in 2019; your score will follow you to your new practice/organization. This means your score and its affiliated payment adjustment will be applied to your new practice in 2020. The MIPS score can influence both how organizations may contract with newly-hired clinicians and how clinicians may evaluate practices/organizations.

CMS will provide preliminary MIPS scores and feedback directly to the clinicians around July. Final scoring will be made publicly available in November 2018. Clinicians should be aware of their MIPS performance score and its impact on their professional reputation. Every historical MIPS score earned by a clinician is a permanent part of a publicly-reported record released and managed by CMS. This information will be available in downloaded format for public consumption.
